OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BICESTER, BICESTER ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER 20**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

As a result of a new access road that leads to the allotments, adjacent to Bicester Road, approximately 46 metres south of its roundabout junction with the A4421, the County Council is proposing, for road safety reasons, to introduce a “No Right Turn” prohibition (i.e. only left turns permitted) for traffic entering the Bicester Road, from the new access road. Traffic travelling towards Launton will have to go around the roundabout. These works form part of the East West Rail – Phase 2 project.

The County Council continues its responsibility to consider the provision of convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measure is aimed at ensuring that ¹ danger is minimised whilst ² facilitating the effective and safe passage of traffic.
