

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LAUNTON PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 202***

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Launton Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 2023.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. The Oxfordshire County Council (Launton Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 2023 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

30mph 20mph Speed Limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Launton (excluding those listed in schedule 2) extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Bicester Road	a point 162 metres northwest of its junction with The Spinney.
b)	Blackthorn Road	a point 250 metres southeast of its junction with Station Road.
c)	Station Road	a point 205 metres north-east of its junction with Blenheim Drive.

SCHEDULE 2

40mph Speed Limit:

Bicester Road	from a point 162 metres northwest of its junction with The Spinney, north-westwards	to its roundabout junction with the A4421 Charbridge Lane.
