

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LAUNTON PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the order - in support of road safety issues - is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** throughout Launton, replacing the existing 30mph speed limits in their entirety - leading outwards to the following points:

1. Bicester Road – a point 162 metres north-west of its junction with The Spinney,
2. Blackthorn Road – a point 250 metres southeast of its junction with Station Road,
3. Station Road – a point 205 metres northeast of its junction with Blenheim Drive.

The existing 40mph speed limit on the Bicester Road leading from the village to the A4421 Charbridge Lane roundabout junction will remain in place, with Officers having taken the current road environment & traffic usage into account.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Launton Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
